Eligibility, Submission Requirements and Rules

- Our team awards are open to any organization actively engaged in the UAS/UAM/AAM industries. Eligible organizations include businesses, government agencies, nonprofits, etc.
- Nominees for the team categories must have at least one woman actively involved in the project or initiative.
- Team nominations can be comprised of co-ed (female and male) or all female members.
- The Individual Awards nominees must be a woman actively engaged in the UAS/UAM/AAM industries.
- Previous honorees can be nominated if involved in a venture different from one that was previously recognized by the Women And Drones Awards program.
- A Women And Drones membership is not a requirement.
- All honorees (individual and teams) will be announced through the Women And Drones communication platforms including website, press release, e-newsletter, e-magazine, social media, and member communication.
- Honorees will be invited to accept their award live during a presentation at the 2021 InterDrone conference in Dallas, TX.
- A \$500 micro-grant and trophy will be awarded to the honorees in the individual categories. One micro-grant and one trophy will also be presented to Company/team honoree for the organization.
- Nominations must be submitted online via the nomination link on the nomination launch page.
- You may nominate an individual or team for more than one category however, each nomination requires a separate online entry submission.
- Your entry entitles Women And Drones the rights to use company names, logos and images for promotional materials created by or for Women And Drones.
- Your entry in the awards process indicates an agreement to abide by the Women And Drones Submission Requirements, Rules and Regulations.
- Women And Drones reserve the right to interpret and apply these rules and regulations without claim for damage or recourse of any kind.
- The decisions of Women And Drones and the judges are final.
- Any updates to the submission requirements, rules and regulations will be added to this document on an as needed basis.
